Plaintiffs CATALYST, a registered name of New Moon Press, Inc., ERIC LEE PIPER and PRISONER'S LEGAL NEWS, a Washington non-profit corporation, by and through counsel, Brian M. Barnard and James L. Harris, Jr. and the defendants BOX ELDER COUNTY, a

government entity, **D. LEON JENSEN**, Sheriff of Box Elder County, **Sgt. CURTIS HANSEN**, Commander, Box Elder County Jail, by and through counsel Jon Bunderson, Box Elder County Attorney in full settlement of this action agree and stipulate as follows:

1. Defendants admit no wrong doing. Defendants' position is that they have never violated the civil rights of the plaintiffs in this action. Defendants are entering into this agreement simply to end costly and unnecessary litigation.

2. For compromise and settlement of all possible claims arising out of the pleadings, including all possible attorney fees and court costs arising out of this litigation, defendants shall pay to plaintiffs' counsel the sum of two thousand two hundred dollars (\$2,200.00).

3. Payment to be made as set forth above shall be made to plaintiffs' counsel on or before December 15, 1998. If payment is not so made, this stipulation and agreement is null and void.

4. Upon timely receipt of the payment as set forth above, plaintiffs' counsel shall file with the Court a signed dismissal with prejudice under Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 41. Receipt of a signed (but as yet not filed) copy of that dismissal is acknowledged by defendants' counsel.


5. Defendants acknowledge that they are in the process of drafting policies regarding inmate mail and reading materials.

In good faith, defendants will do their utmost to ensure that these new policies meet all applicable constitutional requirements. In the event that the new policies, when implemented and enforced, are unsatisfactory to plaintiffs, plaintiffs are free to bring another suit based upon those new policies.
