- 7. Photographs (duplicates, color or laser copies preferred) of the location and of injuries, if scarring is claimed.
- 8. Proof of any special damages claimed.
- 9. Any other item(s) that you believe pertinent to an early resolution of your case.

ALLEGED POLICE MISCONDUCT

- 1. Any police reports in your possession.
- Arrest report and photographs.
- Certified copy of the disposition of any criminal proceedings.
- Witness statements.
- Complaint report and any follow-up reports.
- 6. If reimbursement of legal fees is claimed, copies of any bills incurred.
