I believe the role of the FBI and Agents in such situations must be clearly defined. At the time of my deployment to GTMO, the understanding conveyed to me was that the U.S. Military was the lead agency, they had their own rules that they were operating under, and our role was to conduct FBI business by coordinating with Military personnel without interfering in their accepted practices. We were provided with a copy of approved interrogation techniques to give some clarification as to their accepted practices. Should the FBI be taking on the role of "policing" other agencies, that role should be clearly communicated to Agents prior to and during their deployment.
