FBI agents typically conduct their jobs in a permissive operating environment, conducting interviews of suspects for the purpose of gathering information to support elements of a specific crime. Military and Intelligence Service Operatives conduct interviews and interrogations for different purposes. Understanding the difference and knowing what techniques were permissible by the military

and intelligence services in a wartime environment would have been useful.
