- 26. Please provide any additional information concerning training for overseas deployments of assignments of FBI personnel you believe is relevant.
- (1) Have CDC's provide legal guidance to FBI personnel deploying overseas; including country specific information. When I joined the FBI, I signed a paper advising I would accept travel the requirement of travel as part of my job, but I do not recall any information advising of my status, rights, responsibilities, and obligations as a U.S. federal law enforcement officer in the international environment;
- (2) Provide instruction on FBI responsibilities during armed conflicts or during declared wars. I was taught to interview witnesses and interview/interrogate subjects/suspects. No training was provided on interviewing and interrogation of Prisoners of War or more specifically "Unlawful Enemy Combatants".
- (3) Advise FBI personnel of obligations regarding the reporting of questionable activities by peers from other intelligence organizations in environments such as GTMO. Apparently, some high-value detainees were "silently" removed from the general population at Camp Delta. As Administrative Agent, I was required to report a set number of detainees being held, yet some would be taken away by unknown intelligence personnel (non-FBI) and the reporting number would have to change;
- (4) If I am correct, Guantanamo Bay Naval Base is on leased property from Cuba; therefore, it's not considered sovereign territory for the "war on terrorism" but there is a U.S. military base that occupies the space. So, no Legat is located there. Yet Naval Security Police have jurisdiction for violations committed on the base? What exactly is the status of GTMO and Camp Delta? And what role does the FBI truly have in such an environment? What roles do the CIA, DHS, Customs, NYPD, and military intelligence have in this environment as well?

Immediately after transport from Afghanistan to Guantanamo Bay, several detainees were placed in a fenced-in area (the "pumpkin patch") adjacent to the medical trailer at Camp Delta. The detainees were primarily made to sit in kneeling position, with blindfolds and if I remember correctly, earphones and 'surgeon' masks over their noses and mouths. Some detainees fainted in the heat and were immediately revived by medical personnel. As I was not directly involved in the transport, nor do I have knowledge of US military policy on transport of "unlawful enemy combatants" I am not in a position to assume this activity was beyond the scope of the military's duties.
