I don't think we had any training in this area, specific to these detainees. However, our mindset going in and throughout the interviews was that these detainees should be interviewed and interrogated like any other terrorism suspect in detention (in the US or outside the US).

I have heard that the FBI has a much improved training program for people being deployed currently. As long as Agents know what the Bureau policy is regarding acceptable standards and practices, I think Agents will be fine. Secondly, as an Agent deployed overseas, I need to know who I am reporting to and who my "link" is with the FBI at HQ. This was not fully developed during the time of my deployment to Afghanistan.
