I feel the FBI, along with Agents from the United States Customs Service (now ICE under DHS) and other Federal US Governmental Law Enforcement Agencies acted in a professional manner and all knew that they were subject to the same laws and codes of conduct that they are in the US. Following the Abu Gharib scandal, everyone has become ultra cognizant of any interview/interrogation technique that is used, which is good in cases that involve physical and mental abuse and torture (which I did not see). On the flip side, this has been taken to an extreme and has become a detraction because the military and other Gov. agencies are barred from doing things that we do to our own soldiers during any SERE exercise. During my time in Iraq, I was assigned to some highly classified units, duties, and installations, and during all of it I have not seen anything that I feel would amount to the FBI opening any type of civil rights case if it were to happen in the United States. Furthermore, the use of deception and misleading statements during interviews are used daily by law enforcement agencies throughout the US.

What many individuals who have not been in the places and positions we have, do not understand is that the detainees that the FBI and others are interviewing are highly trained in the use of counter interrogation, deception and misinformation. All Agents that are in Iraq should already know that during there time there that they cannot do anything that we can't and wouldn't do in the US. I feel the FBI and other LEA's in Iraq acted professionally and fully within the Constitution of the United States, within their

given agencies policies and within the Geneva Convention concerning the rules of war.
