LITIGATION ANALYSIS

The number of lawsuits filed in this quarter decreased from the previous quarter, with 441 filed in the fourth quarter of 1994 and 348 filed this quarter. The amount of awards/settlements in this quarter was less than in the previous quarter, with \$519,870 in the fourth quarter and \$5,150 this quarter. Although the total number of lawsuits and the dollar amount of settlements was significantly less this quarter than in previous quarters, it is premature to draw any conclusions from this data regarding litigation trends.

1995 QUARTERLY LITIGATION REPORT

FIRST QUARTER

I. SIGNIFICANT HEARINGS AND TRIALS

MID-ATLANTIC REGION

Michelle Murray v. Officer Harris, 93-259, E.D. Ky.

On November 29, 1994, a jury deliberated less than 30 minutes before delivering a favorable verdict for Tim Harris, a correctional officer at FCI Ashland. Inmate Murray is a preoperative transsexual who filed suit against numerous Ashland staff, alleging verbal and physical harassment. Officer Harris had been accused of improper sexual contact during a visual search of inmate Michelle Murray.

Mayer v. U.S., 92-2677-HA, W.D. Tenn.

Trial in this Federal Tort Claims Act (FTCA) case was held on December 1, 1994. This case involved a claim of failure to protect a former inmate who was stabbed at FCI Memphis. A favorable outcome is anticipated.

NORTHEAST REGION

<u>Bilgrami v. Turner</u>, 93-1223, M.D. Pa.

This case was remanded from the Third Circuit for consideration of prior custody credit in light of <u>Koray v. Sizer</u>, 21 F.3d 558 (3d Cir. 1994), <u>petition for certiorari granted</u>, No. 94-790 (January 1995). Petitioner Bilgrami requested prior custody credit for 20 months spent under restrictive conditions of release. The district court dismissed the petition. On appeal, the Third Circuit remanded for consideration under <u>Koray</u>, and retained jurisdiction over the appeal. Following a hearing, the court held that under the <u>Koray</u> standard, Petitioner was to be afforded prior custody credit. The Bureau reserved the right to reincarcerate Petitioner if the court order is reversed or vacated. The Third Circuit has stayed the briefing scheduled pending completion of Supreme Court review in Koray.

SOUTHEAST REGION

<u>Vladimir Collazo-Leon v. Bureau of Prisons, et al.</u>, 94-1616 CC, D. P.R.

This case involves a pretrial detainee at MDC-Guaynabo who was found guilty of attempted bribery of a correctional officer in the amount of one million dollars, to assist in his escape. The sanctions imposed included 90 days institution disciplinary segregation and the loss of social visiting and non-legal telephone privileges for six months. The court ordered the BOP to release the pretrial detainee from segregation and to restore his privileges because DHO sanctions were punishment and a pretrial inmate has a constitutional right to be free from punishment. The decision is on appeal to the First Circuit.

CENTRAL OFFICE/LITIGATION BRANCH

Conchita Washington, et al., v. Janet Reno, et al., Civ. Nos.: 93-217/93-290, E.D. Ky.

Following a hearing on November 4, 1994, the court held the BOP in contempt for violating its order not to retaliate against the named plaintiffs for their participation in this lawsuit. The contempt order arose out of a disciplinary action taken in October 1994 against inmate Washington, one of the named plaintiffs. As part of an overall set of work reassignments necessitated by the gradually diminishing female population at FMC Lexington, inmate Washington was assigned to new work detail as an orderly in the library. She refused a direct order to clean and was charged with violating prison rules by refusing the work order. The court found that the Bureau retaliated against the inmate by changing her work status. The court ordered that the sanction imposed be lifted immediately. The Bureau recommended to the Solicitor General that this order be appealed.

II. SETTLEMENTS

NORTHEAST REGION

Craveiro v. Luther, 93-154, W.D. Pa.

FTCA lost property claim was settled for \$150.00.

WESTERN REGION

Sherilyn Wohl V. United States, N.D. Cal.

The plaintiff agreed to accept \$5,000 in settlement of her FTCA action. She had sought \$750,000 alleging that an unsafe picnic table at FCI Dublin fell over on her causing her to suffer a miscarriage. Although there was substantial doubt whether any accident happened or whether it precipitated her miscarriage, there was also a lack of Bureau records indicating the result of any investigation of her reported injury at the time of her miscarriage.

III.CASES OF INTEREST

NORTH CENTRAL REGION

Danny Weeks v. United States, 94-3381-RDR, D. Kan.

The pro se plaintiff/inmate brought this FTCA action and alleges he was assaulted and battered during a forced cell move at USP Leavenworth. He also claims malicious prosecution for disciplinary proceedings held for his attempted escape from the USP. The plaintiff seeks a declaratory judgment and \$200,000 in compensation. The Assistant U.S. Attorney (AUSA) defending the case has motioned for a sixty-day extension of time to answer.

Kerry Dixon v. United States, et al., 94-3309-RDR, D. Kan.

The plaintiff, like his cell-mate Danny Weeks, seeks compensation under the FTCA for torts allegedly committed during a forced cell move at USP Leavenworth. The plaintiff is represented by counsel. Additionally, the plaintiff alleges constitutional violations under the Eighth, Fifth, and Sixth Amendments of the U.S. Constitution. The plaintiff further claims several violations of the Kansas State Constitution. The plaintiff requests injunctive relief and unspecified money damages. The AUSA, who is also defending the <u>Weeks</u> case, is asking opposing counsel for a sixty-day extension of time to answer.

NORTHEAST REGION

Oliveira v. Byerly, 94-1665, M.D. Pa.

Inmate Sergio Oliveira filed a petition for habeas corpus challenging the disallowance of good conduct time. On November 7, 1994, the district court held that Bureau policy did not permit the disallowance of good conduct time already awarded and ordered that the good conduct time be awarded. This resulted in the inmate's immediate release. The Central Office DHA is revising the policy.

SOUTH CENTRAL REGION

<u>Hieu Duc Tran v. George Killinger</u>, 4:94-CV-809-A, N.D. Tex.

This is a <u>Bivens</u> case where the defendants were not served. The Judge ordered issuance of the summons and service of the complaint. The Judge also ordered the Bureau not to transfer plaintiff and appointed an attorney to investigate plaintiff's claims, but not to represent him. The DOJ Appellate Division and the U.S. Attorney's office have been alerted to this decision and possible appeal.

SOUTHEAST REGION

Anthony Cash v. Joseph Class, MCA 92-50199/RV, N.D. Fla.

This case involved a Hebrew inmate at FCI-Marianna. He alleged that in 1992 he was not allowed to use the institution chapel for his religious worship. The magistrate recommended dismissal after applying the standard established by the Religious Freedom Restoration Act. The magistrate found that the defendants should be entitled to qualified immunity because the actions in question occurred in 1992. On October 3, 1994, the district court judge adopted the magistrate's report and dismissed the case. On November 30, 1994, the inmate appealed to the Eleventh Circuit.

SETTLEMENTS FIRST QUARTER

North Central Region

1. <u>Terms</u>. The complainant alleged that she was discriminated against on the basis of her sex and age (40) when she was assigned to a temporary position as an Inmate Systems Supervisor at the Federal Medical Center, Rochester, Minnesota. This complaint of discrimination was withdrawn on December 7, 1994, prior to the investigation. The complainant indicated that she had received the relief that she sought.

<u>Reason for Settlement</u>. This complaint was withdrawn at the request of the complainant.

2. <u>Terms</u>. The complaint alleged that she was discriminated against on the basis of her sex when a man was hired to the position of Engineering Technician, GS-11, at the Federal Medical Center, Rochester, Minnesota. She had vacated this position at a lower grade level. This complaint was settled on November 9, 1994, prior to a hearing by the Equal Employment Opportunity Commission (EEOC). The settlement agreement provided that the complainant will receive a settlement in the amount of \$6,250.

<u>Reason for Settlement</u>. This complaint was settled by the Labor Law Branch staff prior to the hearing being conducted.

Northeast Region

1. <u>Terms</u>. This complaint was settled on November 23, 1994. The complainant alleged that he had been discriminated against because of his disability (hearing impairment) when he was removed from his position as an Electronics Technician at the Federal Correctional Institution, Fort Dix, New Jersey when he did not pass the academic portion of the training at the Federal Law Enforcement Training Center, Glynco, Georgia. The complainant's SF-50 was changed from "Termination" to "Resignation for Personal Reasons."

Reason for Settlement. The complaint was settled by the EEO Investigator through factfinding/mediation prior to the investigation being conducted.

2. <u>Terms</u>. This complaint was settled on October 31, 1994. The complainant alleged that he was discriminated against because of his race (Hispanic) when he was terminated during his probationary period from his position as a Correctional Officer at the Federal Correctional Institution, Schuylkill, Pennsylvania. The complainant's SF-50 was changed from "Termination" to "Resignation for Personal Reasons." **Reason for Settlement.** This complaint was settled by the EEO Investigator through factfinding/mediation prior to the investigation being conducted.

3. <u>Terms</u>. This complaint was settled on October 25, 1994. The complainant alleged that she was discriminated against because of her race (African American) and her sex when: (1) She was not issued safety shoes; (2) She received a lower performance appraisal than her peers; (3) She received a reprimand; and (4) She was not vouchered in the same manner as her peer. The complaint was settled for the complainant being issued a pair of safety shoes in accordance with Bureau policy.

<u>Reason for Settlement</u>. This complaint was settled through factfinding/mediation by the EEO Investigator.

4. <u>Terms</u>. The complainant filed a complaint against the Federal Correctional Institution, Fort Dix, New Jersey alleging that she was discriminated against because of her physical disability when she did not receive assistance to manage the Inmate Systems Department which resulted in her reassignment to another position. The complainant withdrew her complaint on October 28, 1994, after discussions with the EEO Investigator.

<u>Reason for Settlement</u>. This complaint was settled through factfinding/mediation by the EEO Investigator.

5. <u>Terms</u>. This complaint filed against the Federal Correctional Institution, Fairton, New Jersey, was settled on November 9, 1994. The complaint filed against the Federal Correctional Institution, Fairton, New Jersey, alleged that he was discriminated against on the basis of race (Black), his religion (Methodist), sex, and mental handicap when he was terminated from his position as a Correctional Officer. The complainant's SF-50 was changed from "Termination" to "Resignation for Personal Reasons."

<u>Reason for Settlement</u>. This complaint was settled through factfinding/mediation prior to the investigation by the EEO Investigator.

6. <u>Terms</u>. The complaint filed against the U.S. Penitentiary, Lewisburg, Pennsylvania was settled on November 17, 1994. The complainant alleged that he was discriminated against because of his national origin (Puerto Rican) when management required him to produce leave slips for his absences and his disability was not accommodated. The complainant's SF-50 was changed to indicate that he had "Resigned for Personal Reasons."

Reason for Settlement. The complaint was settled through factfinding/mediation by the EEO Investigator prior to the investigation being conducted.

Southeast

1. <u>Terms</u>. The complainant alleged that he was discriminated against by the Southeast Region because of his national origin (American Indian) when: (1) He received a three-day suspension; (2) He was placed on home duty status; and (3) He was reassigned from his position as Chief Correctional Officer, GS-11, at the Federal Prison Camp, Maxwell AFB, Alabama to the U.S. Penitentiary, Atlanta, Georgia, as a Correctional Supervisor, GS-11. The complaint was settled on November 2, 1994, by the Labor Law Branch prior to a hearing being conducted by the Equal Employment Opportunity Commission. The complainant's record will be expunged of the three-day suspension, and he will receive retroactive pay.

<u>Reason for Settlement</u>. This complaint was settled prior to the hearing by EEOC by the Labor Law Branch.

2. <u>Terms</u>. The complainant alleged that he was discriminated against by the U.S. Penitentiary, Atlanta, Georgia because of his race (Black) and subjected to reprisal for filing prior complaints of discrimination. The complainant withdrew this complaint on December 9, 1994, prior to the complaint being accepted for processing because he had filed a prior complaint on the same allegations that he raised in this complaint.

<u>Reason for Settlement</u>. This complaint was withdrawn by the complainant after discussion with a staff member in the EEO Complaints Section.

3. <u>Terms</u>. The complaint against the Federal Correctional Institution, Talladega, was withdrawn by the complainant on November 30, 1994. The complainant alleged that he was discriminated against because of his race (Black) when he was not selected for the position of Sports Specialist at the Federal Correctional Institution, Talladega, Alabama.

<u>Reason for Settlement</u>. This complaint was withdrawn by the complainant after discussion with the EEO Investigator.

Western Region

1. Terms. The complaint filed against the Federal Correctional Institution, Terminal Island, California was settled on December 16, 1994. The complainant alleged that he was discriminated against because of his race (Black) and reprisal when his supervisor placed negative entries regarding his job performance in his Significant Incident Log in violation of agency policy between September and December, 1988, and (2) he was involuntarily transferred, effective February 26, 1989, from his supervisory position as a Health Systems Administrator, GS- 670-11, at the FCI Terminal Island to the position of Medical Technical Assistant, GS-650-11, at MDC Los Angeles. The complainant received a settlement fee of \$2,414.00 and his last SF-50 will be changed to reflect that he retired as a Health Systems Administrator.

<u>Reason for Settlement</u>. This complaint was settled because it was cost effective since the complaint had been remanded to the agency for hearing by EEOC.

Ethics Training Conducted for Federal Bureau of SUBJECT: Prisons Personnel

I am pleased to report that Ethics training has been provided to 39 employees of the Federal Bureau of Prisons in four separate training sessions for the period covering October 1, 1994, to January 30, 1995.

The four training sessions include the following:

- (1) An Ethics and Sexual Harassment training session of two and one-half hours was offered to six employees as part of New Employee Orientation on October 18, 1994.
- An Ethics & Procurement Integrity Training session for (2) Community Corrections Managers was offered to 10 people at the Northeast Regional Office on October 26, 1994.
- (3) An Ethics Training session of three hours was offered to fourteen employees attending New Attorney Training at the Management and Specialty Training Center, on November 18, 1994.
- An Ethics and Sexual Harassment training session of two and (4) one-fourth hours was offered to nine employees as part of New Employee Orientation on December 13, 1994.

QUARTERLY REPORT - ADMINISTRATIVE REMEDIES

OCTOBER THRU DECEMBER 1994

Administrative Remedy data is provided directly from the Key Indicator (KI/SSS) system. The first three of the attached reports show information on institution filings, regional appeals, and central office appeals aggregated for the Bureau as a whole (BOP - All Institutions). The remaining six reports display by region aggregate information in regional appeals filed by inmates in all institutions in that particular region.

Administrative Remedy data for Community Corrections is provided in Part II of this Quarterly Report.

Some observations about the data in the attached reports.

o The total number of filings for this quarter showed a minuscule decrease at the institution, a decrease at the regional office and a slight increase at the central office levels. Institution filings went from 3,224 to 3,214; regional appeals from 1,829 to 1,759; and central office appeals from 695 to 703.

o Grant rates for this quarter remained relatively the same at the institution and regional levels and showed a slight increases at the central office level. The grant rate at the institution level for this quarter was 15.5%, the exact same as last quarter. The grant rate at the regional office level was 10.2%, compared to 10.3% the previous quarter. The grant rate at the central office level was 3.2%, compared to 2.7% the previous quarter.

o Staff complaints continue as the highest category at the institution level, and remained quite stable from the previous quarter (13.2% or 423 of the 3,214 filed compared to 13.7% or 443 of the 3,224 filed the previous quarter).

o UDC actions was the second highest category at the institution level. UDC actions made up 12.9%, or 414 of the 3,214 requests filed. Last quarter, UDC actions also ranked as the second highest category at 11.5%, or 378 of the 3,224 requests filed.

o Other categories in the top ten at the institution level were: Medical (11.2%), Classification (6.6%), Institution Operations (6.5%), Community Programs (5.8%), Work Assignments (5.8%), Legal (5.4%), Transfer (4.6%), and Institution Programs (4.4%). UDC actions (414 requests) again surpassed Medical complaints (360 requests) as the second highest category, maintaining a trend for the entire year. The categories in the top ten remained fairly constant.

o For regional appeals, the top five categories were: DHO appeals (38.5%, up from 36.1%); UDC Actions (7.8%, up from 6.2%); Medical (6.3%, down from 6.5%); Classification (5.7%, down from 7.2%); and Staff Complaints (5.6%, down from 7.3%). Staff Complaints fell from the second highest category the previous quarter to the fifth highest category this quarter. The same categories remained in the top five.

o The highest number of regional appeals (434) was filed in the Northeast Region, which has the highest number of inmates (17,648). The lowest number of appeals (206) was filed in the South Central Region, which has the third highest number of inmates (14,263). The North Central Region had the second highest number of appeals filed (371), with the lowest number of inmates (11,907).

o The highest percentage of grants at the regional office level was in the Mid-Atlantic Region (21.5% or 51). Fourteen of the 51 grants were in the DHO appeals category. The second highest percentage of grants was in the Southeast Region (16.3% or 39). Nineteen of the 37 grants were in the DHO category. The lowest number of grants (16 or 3.6%) was in the Northeast Region, which has the highest number of appeals.

o At the central office level, filings for DHO appeals remained the highest category, but decreased from the last quarter (21.9% or 154, down from 27.6% or 192).

o Central office appeals in the Medical category (10.0% or 70) rose from the fourth highest category last quarter to the second highest category. The remaining categories in the top five were: Classification (8.1% or 57 appeals); and Staff and Jail Time (both 8.0% or 56).

We are pleased to provide this CRIPA Quarterly Activity Report for the period of October 1, 1994, through December 31, 1994.

JURISDICTIONS CERTIFIED

There were no jurisdictions certified in this quarter.

PENDING APPLICATIONS

Hawaii Department of Public Safety - A review of Hawaii's application for full certification was completed on November 9, 1994. Comments and suggested modifications were provided, and we are awaiting a response.

Fulton County Jail, Georgia - There is no change in status from last quarter. We are still awaiting their response to the comments and suggestions made in our formal review of their application for certification.

Michigan Department of Corrections - On December 12, 1994, Michigan submitted a revised grievance procedure which incorporated our suggested modifications. We are awaiting their final draft and Spanish translation in order to recommend full certification.

County of Bucks, PA. - Bucks County has advised us of their intention to seek full certification. This jurisdiction had been granted conditional certification on December 8, 1992.

CORRESPONDENCE

Rhode Island Department of Corrections - The state has advised that in light of personnel changes, they are ready to pursue certification and has requested assistance in developing a certifiable grievance procedure. We contacted certified jurisdictions in the Northeast, and coordinated their assistance to Rhode Island.

Vermont Department of Corrections - They, too, have undergone personnel changes. This jurisdiction has requested information regarding the status of their previous application, and indicated their intent to submit a new application.

During the quarter, the National Inmate Appeals Section has provided information on certified jurisdictions in the Ninth Circuit to the Deputy Circuit Executive in San Francisco, California. Last quarter, we provided similar information to the federal court in the state of Washington. The federal judiciary in that circuit continues to express an interest in CRIPA.

As usual, we continue to receive correspondence from inmates and other parties interested in CRIPA.

STRATEGIES

We have proposed language modifying regulations to conform with changes in the law. Our updated CRIPA Handbook will be edited to reflect final changes in the regulations.
