The CASA of Maryland group representing 24 apprehended aliens, are alleging that racial profiling was utilized & that civil rights have been violated.

412	On January 23, 2007, DRO officers from the Baltimore Field Office conducted a fugitive operation as part of the larger "Operation Return to Sender". At the end of the operation, because the apprehension numbers were lower than had been anticipated, the Acting Field Office Director, John Alderman, ordered the officers back out into the field make more arrests. The purpose of a "fugitive operation" is to target allens who are subject to final orders of removal but who have falled to depart the U.S. as required. On this particular day, officers arrested 24 Hispanic males who had gathered at a local 7 -Eleven store known to be a hangout for day laborers seeking employment. The initial reports provided to upper management, HQDRO, and subsequently forwarded to the Assistant Secretary indicated that the fugitive teams had merely pulled into this 7-Eleven parking lot to "re-group" and/or strategize before hitting a target location and that these allens approached the officers asking about employment, thereby kicking off questioning about allenage and removability. Reports also indicated that all 24 apprehensions were made on the grounds of the 7 -Eleven. This is how the events of the day were reported and how ICE/DRO conveyed the information to the media.
