

February 2009 VT Segregation Report Highlights

Total segregation (includes inmates with and without serious mental illness (SMI) or seriously functionally impaired (SFI))

- 265 inmates were placed on either administrative or disciplinary segregation. This is about 11.7% of the total number of inmates who came through our doors in February.
- There were 275 episodes of segregation; 102 episodes were for administrative purposes and 173 episodes were for disciplinary purposes.

Segregation subtotals for inmates with serious mental illness (SMI/SFI)

- Of the 102 episodes of administrative segregation, 5 involved an inmate identified as having a SMI/SFI.
- Of the 173 episodes of disciplinary segregation, 7 involved an inmate identified as having a SMI/SFI.
- The total number of inmates on segregation with a SMI/SFI was 12.
- The statewide average number of inmates identified as having a SMI/SFI for the month of February was 55.
- A total of 23 episodes of self-harm occurred in segregation. Of these, 12 episodes were listed as inmates identified as having a SMI/SFI.
