

According to Ms. [REDACTED] Counselor Aguirre has 3 children [REDACTED], [REDACTED] and [REDACTED]. Her birthday is 2-21-65 and she just turned 41. Ms. [REDACTED] said she has proof of Ms. Aguirre's unwanted attention to include cards and letters. Counselor Aguirre caused Ms. [REDACTED] "girlfriend", [REDACTED] to lose her job in Ellensburg when she called the employer and told him of Ms. [REDACTED] sexual orientation. According to Ms. [REDACTED] Ms. Aguirre has promised to make her life "miserable".

Ms. [REDACTED] told me Counselor Aguirre has been to her mother's home as well as her aunt's home. The mother is [REDACTED] and she can be reached via cell phone at [REDACTED]. Her aunt, [REDACTED] has since moved to No. Carolina.

Ms. [REDACTED] testified that she was denied Drug Offender Sentencing Alternative treatment while in the institution, as Counselor Aguirre wanted her to remain in the unit where she could clean her office. Since her release she has seen Counselor Aguirre and she offered Ms. [REDACTED] drugs and alcohol.

Ms. [REDACTED] said Internal Affairs Officer, Steve Baxter called her home, but she would not talk to him.

All this information is on the tape of the hearing, and was witnessed by Community Corrections Officer Brenda Clark.

I will be completing my report on this hearing next week (but will not include this personnel information). The tape will be forwarded to the CRS at that time if you want to make a copy of it.

Ms. [REDACTED] told me she informed her Community Corrections Officer in Ellensburg of this harassment, but she would not give him the name of the employee as she wanted to wait until she got an attorney. There was nothing in the chronos which referred to this contact.

20. Check with neighbors in [redacted] to see if they remember [redacted] playing with the children in the neighborhood, who were the children.

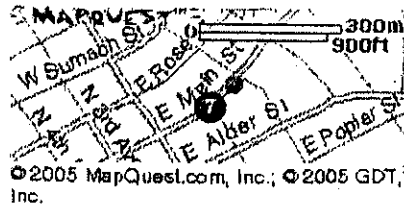
