SUBJECT: POSSIBLE STAFF MISCONDUCT RE: CO JOHN O'NEIL

**SYNOPSIS:** On Wednesday March 9, 2004 WCCW I&I received an E-Mail (see attachment 1) from Sgt. Baccetti CCU Sergeant stating that Correctional Officer (CO) John O'Neil had approached her and related that he was hearing that Inmate (I/M) [REDACTED] (see picture attachment 2) was saying things about him being inappropriate in his job and was going to try and set him up to get him out of the unit. CO O'Neil wrote and turned in an Incident Report on March 9, 2004 (see attachment 3). Sgt. Baccetti interviewed I/M [REDACTED] who stated that she felt that someone in the east pod was trying to set her up and making up the rumors about her and CO O'Neil. Later that night I/M [REDACTED] approached Sgt. Baccetti and stated that she had overheard I/M [REDACTED] making untrue statements about CO O'Neil. On Thursday March 10, 2004 I&I interviewed I/M [REDACTED] in the CCU Sgt.'s office and was told by I/M [REDACTED] that there was no truth to the allegations and that there had been no inappropriate behavior by CO O'Neil. Later that afternoon Investigator Baxter was approached by CO O'Neil outside of the main campus education building and expressed concern about the rumors. Investigator Baxter related to CO O'Neil that the allegations were being looked into and if there were no basis for them then he had nothing to worry about.

On Thursday March 11, 2004 I/M [REDACTED]'s cellmate [REDACTED] sent a kite (see attachment 4) to WCCW I&I and stated that she really felt that we should talk to her. I/M [REDACTED] was interviewed that day and stated that she felt that there was a relationship between I/M [REDACTED] and CO O'Neil. Inmate [REDACTED]'s observations included whenever CO O'Neil was assigned to East pod he was spending most of his time on West pod where I/M [REDACTED] lived. I/M [REDACTED] had seen love notes written by I/M [REDACTED] and then had seen I/M [REDACTED] pass something to him though she could not verify that's what was passed. I/M [REDACTED] also gave the names of other inmates that could be questioned.

On Friday 3/12/04 Inmate [REDACTED] was again interviewed and at this time admitted to the following was true about CO O'Neil:

- Flirting with him in the pod
- Passing love notes to him on several occasions
- Flashing her breasts to him on several occasions

I/M [REDACTED] was requested to write a written statement see (see attachment 5) and agreed to take a polygraph. On 3/14/04 Sgt. Baccetti placed I/M [REDACTED] in segregation for talking about the case with other inmates and causing a disturbance.

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**INVESTIGATIVE INTERVIEWS:**

Inmate [REDACTED] Stated in her written statement of 3/12/04 and received by I&I on 3/15/04 the following allegations/information:

- They had begun to make eye contact and she had written him a poem which he accepted that night
- CO O'Neil had begun coming by her room every night to say goodnight
- She had passed him a further 2 to 3 notes
- CO O'Neil had told her he was separated and a single father
- That she had flashed him on at least two occasions in her room during tier checks

Inmate [REDACTED] was administered a polygraph examination (see attachment 6) at which time she was asked the following questions:

1. Has Officer O'Neil ever taken any love notes directly from you?
2. Have you ever shown your breasts to Officer O'Neil?

Based on the physiology responses produced by the subject on three (3) polygraph charts, in the opinion of the examiner, she was not attempting deception when she answered, "yes" to the questions above. A second examiner independently reviewed the charts and concurred with the first conclusions that she was not attempting deception when she answered yes to the above questions.

Inmate [REDACTED] was interviewed again on 3/15/04 and stated that she still believed that something was going on with CO O'Neil and I/M [REDACTED] but was afraid to say it to Sgt. Baccetti. Some of the allegations made by I/M [REDACTED] are the following:

- I/M [REDACTED] claims she saw a love note written by I/M [REDACTED] I/M [REDACTED] then saw I/M [REDACTED] place another piece of paper over the note then slip the paper into the CCU Booth's drawer. She could not confirm that the note was under the paper but did not see I/M [REDACTED] with the note when she returned to the dayroom table.
- Heard CO O'Neil on the room intercom talk to I/M [REDACTED] saying "Hey, [REDACTED] how are you doing?" Inmate [REDACTED] replied "good" when I/M [REDACTED] stated that she was in the room also CO O'Neil said "I'm just checking that all the people that moved today are settled."
- I/M [REDACTED] stated that CO O'Neil would allow I/M [REDACTED] to leave the room after lockdown to get water and ice while refusing other inmates.

I/M [REDACTED] wrote a written statement for Sgt. Baccetti on 3/14/04 (see attachment 7).

Sgt. Andrea Baccetti, CCU Sergeant: wrote and turned in an incident to I&I dated 3/14/04(see attachment 8) In this incident report Sgt. Baccetti stated that CO O'Neil had approached her on 03/04/04 saying that inmates had been coming to him telling him that I/M [REDACTED] was out to get him because he infringed them so much. Later that night I/M [REDACTED] came forward and gave Sgt. Baccetti a note (see attachment 9) she had intercepted from I/M [REDACTED] to I/M [REDACTED] in this note I/M [REDACTED] asked I/M [REDACTED] to lie about what she had told her about CO O'Neil. I/M [REDACTED] also said a letter (see attachment 10) was coming back that she had mailed to I/M [REDACTED] while she was in court and to lie about what was in it also.

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Inmate [REDACTED] was interviewed on 3/15/04 and denied that she had any knowledge of the relationship or what the note or letter was talking about.

Inmate [REDACTED]: wrote a statement (see attachment 11) on 3/14/04 in which she states that she had heard I/M [REDACTED] on several occasions state that she would enjoy more that just a normal staff/offender relationship with CO O'Neil. I/M [REDACTED] also stated that she had intercepted a note (see attachment 9) where I/M [REDACTED] asked I/M [REDACTED] to lie for her. I/M [REDACTED] also stated that she had heard that I/M [REDACTED] had made a phone call to her mother on 3/9/04 in which she had told the truth about the situation. I/M [REDACTED] believes that CO O'Neil is innocent of the allegations.

Inmate [REDACTED] was initially interviewed on 3/15/04 and stated that she didn't know anything and didn't want to get involved. A letter (see attachment 12) was later received from her boyfriend in RJC talking about the officer who keeps coming to see you. When confronted with the letter the inmate initially lied and said it was about an officer she knew at the county jail. Later I/M [REDACTED] came forward and stated that she had been untruthful to me before and wanted to talk. I/M [REDACTED] wrote a statement (see attachment 13) of which the following are highlights:

- Talked to her and her roommate (I/M [REDACTED]) on a frequent basis giving out personnel information like he is separated, single dad, and goes bowling on a regular basis.
- On one occasion he interrupted a personal conversation between the two roommates saying he had heard a lot more of their conversation than they thought.
- I/M [REDACTED] felt that he came sneaking to their door on a regular basis
- I/M [REDACTED] roommate would leave the dayroom table saying I'm going up to the room to talk to O'Neil.
- I/M O'Neil's roommate once came in from outside and stated O'Neil just asked me if was cold outside because he could see my nipples poking out.
- I/M [REDACTED] told her that CO O'Neil had come to her room and asked to speak to her and when she said no then threatened to place her in segregation for smoking.
- I/M [REDACTED] told I/M [REDACTED] that CO O'Neil is a good guy and she would lie for him.
- Stated that CO O'Neil would allow her roommate special door racks to allow her to get water, ice or talk to him in the dayroom.

Inmate [REDACTED]: Was interviewed on 3/16/04 and stated that CO O'Neil had come to her room asking to speak with her and she had refused, knowing it was about his relationship with I/M [REDACTED]. I/M [REDACTED] also stated that I/M [REDACTED] had told her that CO O'Neil had made her talk to him about the [REDACTED] case. I/M [REDACTED] thinks that the rumors about CO O'Neil and I/M [REDACTED] are true due to several comments he had made to her these are:

- Since you aren't gay you only mess around with staff and laughed
- CO O'Neil came up to a table where she and several friends were sitting and said unsolicited "why would I mess around with someone like her."
- I/M [REDACTED] once saw him reading a note in the booth afterwards he tore it up to tiny pieces.

Inmate [REDACTED] was interviewed on 3/16/04 and related that he had approached her in her room and asked her to speak to him in the conference room, when she refused he said well you're on a smoking contract you could go to the hole. Inmate [REDACTED] said she had been smoking so she went with him to the conference room. Once in the room he asked her what was going on with [REDACTED] and felt that he must be scared to ask her questions like that and told him he was stupid if he was involved with I/M [REDACTED]. I/M [REDACTED] had seen I/M [REDACTED] write notes to him but not pass them.

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Inmate [REDACTED] was interviewed and stated that I/M [REDACTED] has a crush on CO O'Neil but has never seen anything between the two of them though she has heard him talking on the intercom to inmates and that he is a big flirt.

Inmate [REDACTED]: was interviewed and stated that once when she got off work CO O'Neil had gotten on the intercom and said "heard you did well at work today." I/M [REDACTED] did state that he had interrupted a personal conversation between her and her roommate with an off the wall comment. I/M [REDACTED] denied remembering saying that CO O'Neil had made a comment about it being cold out while looking at her nipples, but wouldn't say it didn't happen just that she didn't remember it.

Inmate [REDACTED] approached I&I and stated that she had a written statement (see attachment 14) In this written statement she has made the following allegations:

- See has seen CO O'Neil flirt with I/M [REDACTED]
- Has observed CO O'Neil watch I/M [REDACTED] intently inside and outside the unit
- Has seen CO O'Neil let I/M [REDACTED] out of room to get ice and hot water when others couldn't
- Has seen CO O'Neil let I/M [REDACTED] eat in the dayroom while not allowing others

Inmate [REDACTED] was interviewed on 3/16/04 and stated that she used to be cellmates with I/M [REDACTED] before being moved to MSU. I/M [REDACTED] stated that she had observed I/M [REDACTED] writing love notes to CO O'Neil on several occasions and one time swatch her pass one of the notes back by the CCU laundry room.

Inmate [REDACTED]: was interviewed on 3/18/04 and made the following statements:

- Stated that once while she was cleaning her room I/M [REDACTED] stopped and talked to her she told her to move on or CO O'Neil would get mad. I/M [REDACTED] said no he won't. CO O'Neil called up on the intercom and said when you're done talking clear the tier.
- I/M [REDACTED] had told her she had passed messages to CO O'Neil
- Had seen CO O'Neil hanging around I/M [REDACTED] door twice
- Had observed CO O'Neil watching (eyeballing) I/M [REDACTED] in the pod

NOTE: this inmate was placed in segregation for actions towards CO O'Neil and may be biased in her testimony.

Inmate [REDACTED] Came to Sgt. Baccetti on 3/24/04 and stated that she had heard inmates [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] speaking on the tier about setting CO O'Neil up.

Inmate [REDACTED]: Wrote a statement (see attachment 15) on 3/14/04 saying that she had heard I/M [REDACTED] bragging about getting CO Magnuson in trouble and that she was having an affair with CO O'Neil. I/M [REDACTED] states that she views this officer as a professional and consistent the majority of the time I/M [REDACTED] also stated that I/M [REDACTED] told her that it infuriated her when CO O'Neil spent time with other inmates getting them forms and such. When interviewed I/M [REDACTED] stated that she had never seen CO O'Neil ever be with I/M [REDACTED] outside the pod not had she ever observed him be anything but professional.

CO Ortega/CCU Officer - wrote a statement dated 3/14/04 saying that he had never observed CO O'Neil act inappropriate towards staff or inmates. (See attachment 16)

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CO Gary Valdez/CCU Officer – wrote a statement dated 3/14/04 saying that he has worked with CO O'Neil for over six months and CO O'Neil has always been professional in his work, integrity and attendance. He went on to say that he has never observed anything unusual towards his behavior with the inmates. (See attachment 17)

Inmate [REDACTED]: wrote a statement on 3/14/04 in which she states that she has never seen CO O'Neil act in any way unprofessional or show any favoritism towards any inmate (see attachment 18.)

CO John O'Neil – was interviewed on 3/14/04 and again on 3/18/04 and denied all allegations except the following:

- Calling I/M [REDACTED]'s room the night she moved and asking how she was doing. CO O'Neil states that he does that to all inmates who have moved the day he is working.
- Admitted to making an off the wall comment to inmates [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] after listening to their conversation over the speaker.
- Admits to reading a note in the booth and tearing it up, explained it was from an inmate telling him Jesus loves him. Inmate [REDACTED] confirms that she did give him a note, but is unable to confirm it was that note.
- CO O'Neil in an IR written 3/14/04 admits to personal conversations with I/M [REDACTED] but that they were conversations dealing with why she was crying in the pod (see attachment 19).

**Investigation Facts:** During this investigation I/M [REDACTED]'s phones and outgoing mail were monitored. On the following dates 3/9/04 and 3/14/04 I/M [REDACTED] made calls to her mother and her boyfriend all in which she talks about CO O'Neil and her relationship with him amounting to flirting and passing of notes. I/M [REDACTED] boyfriend found out about the relationship through a letter that I/M [REDACTED] had mailed to her mother. I/M [REDACTED] at no time during the phone conversation, which escalated into a verbal argument ever, said that she had made it up and it wasn't true. (These conversation may be reviewed in the I&I office) Three outgoing letters were intercepted on 3/21/04 in which I/M [REDACTED] tells friends of her problems with her boyfriend [REDACTED] and how he found out that she had been writing an officer in the prison. (See attachment 20)

**CONCLUSION:** During this investigation inmates have both supportive and have given evidence against CO O'Neil. Evidence that can be supported by more than one witness includes:

- Talking to inmates on the intercom on non work related issues
- Being biased in allowing favors to inmates i.e. letting some inmates out to get ice etc while not allowing others
- Possible passing of notes – several inmates saw something passed but only one can without a doubt say it was the notes they saw I/M [REDACTED] write.
- Insisted that inmate [REDACTED] talk to him in the CCU conference room about the I/M [REDACTED] matter to include mentioning the possibility of segregation if she didn't.

The more serious allegations of taking love notes and watching I/M [REDACTED] flash her breasts cannot be supported by any second witness, it was supported by the positive results of I/M [REDACTED]'s polygraph when she proved truthful in her answers – did you flash CO O'Neil and did you give CO O'Neil love notes. I/M [REDACTED]'s phone conversations and mail also supports her allegations against CO O'Neil.

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RE: Staff Misconduct: John O'Neil

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CO O'Neil does admit that he had made calls on the intercom on other than business reasons and reading a note in the CCU booth then tearing it up but denies all other allegations.

I had officer O'Neil come to my office late last Thursday and say that he is hearing that inmate [REDACTED] is saying things about him that it appears that he is not being appropriate in his job. I told him to write me out a report and give it to me on Monday. I was not here on Monday. He came to me again this evening and gave me an incident report and said that he is hearing more things and that he is hearing that [REDACTED] is trying to set him up to get him out of the unit. I turned in that report to Shift Lt. Simmons who was going to give it to I&I. Inmate [REDACTED] was called into my office because of slamming her door when she was told to cell up by officer O'Neil after not taking a seat and quieting down in the dayroom. Inmate [REDACTED] said that she wanted to speak to me because she feels someone in East pod is trying to set her up and is claiming that she is passing notes to O'Neil. I had not been going to not speak to her until I got with you but, she continued that she felt she was a victim and that she swore that she is nothing but appropriate around O'Neil. She claimed that O'Neil questioned her and Inmate [REDACTED] and inmate [REDACTED] about this. (O'Neil has been told to write out a complete chronological report in regards to what he has been told and what he has said.) I told her that if necessary she would be spoken to further. She stated she was willing to take a polygraph as she had to previously over a another staff and went on to tell me details about that. I told her at this point in time unless directed otherwise I did not want to hear that she is discussing this with any other inmates. While she was in my office inmate [REDACTED] came to the door saying she had to speak to me urgent. When inmate [REDACTED] left my office [REDACTED] came in and stated she is overhearing [REDACTED] say stuff about Officer O'Neil that wasn't true. She also brought up the incident with [REDACTED] and the other staff member. I told her also not to be discussing this with other inmates and that she may be spoken to again. I did not want to get into investigating this if it is not my arena. ( I don't want to tread on your toes). I did want to make you aware of the info as I am hearing it. I have not seen or heard any of the staff in CCU say or act inappropriate. I wanted to make sure this info was passed on so as it can be dealt with. Thanks B.

After I got out of the Hole I passed him notes after my cousin who was here on a violation told me he told her in a conversation he had separated from his wife and got another of his pills, so I asked him about it and he confirmed it so I wrote him, I would tell him I had one, and he would make the way for the exchange. I flirted with him further when I became room-mates with [redacted] and I passed him one evening and he came back and did the motion with his hands for me to do it again so I did and


A polygraph examination was administered to the subject on the above issues.

I have never seen Officer O'Neil ever make any gestures (sexual or otherwise) towards I'm [REDACTED] and I have never seen Officer O'Neil act in an unprofessional manner or inappropriately towards I'm [REDACTED].

I directed him to get with me on Monday and we would sit down and see what was going on as we both were scheduled for Friday, Saturday and Sunday off. I was not here on Monday. Tuesday he asked to be able to talk to me when I had a chance. Sgt. Smith was in my office a little while later when O'Neil came in with an incident report that read that inmates were coming up saying that they had heard inmate [REDACTED] and other talking about him. Inmate [REDACTED] came to him had said she heard that they were out to get him because of him infracting them so much. Officer O'Neil was bothered by the inmate's comment and came to speak with myself and Sgt. Smith. Officer O'Neil requested that I contacted I&I to have this looked into that he wanted it checked out as he stated he was not doing anything wrong and felt she needed investigating. I e mailed Steve Baxter on the information that I had. this week or Next.



I'm on to the Dentist again, this week

right job for you too!

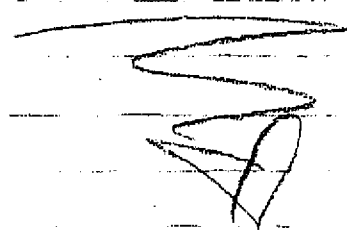

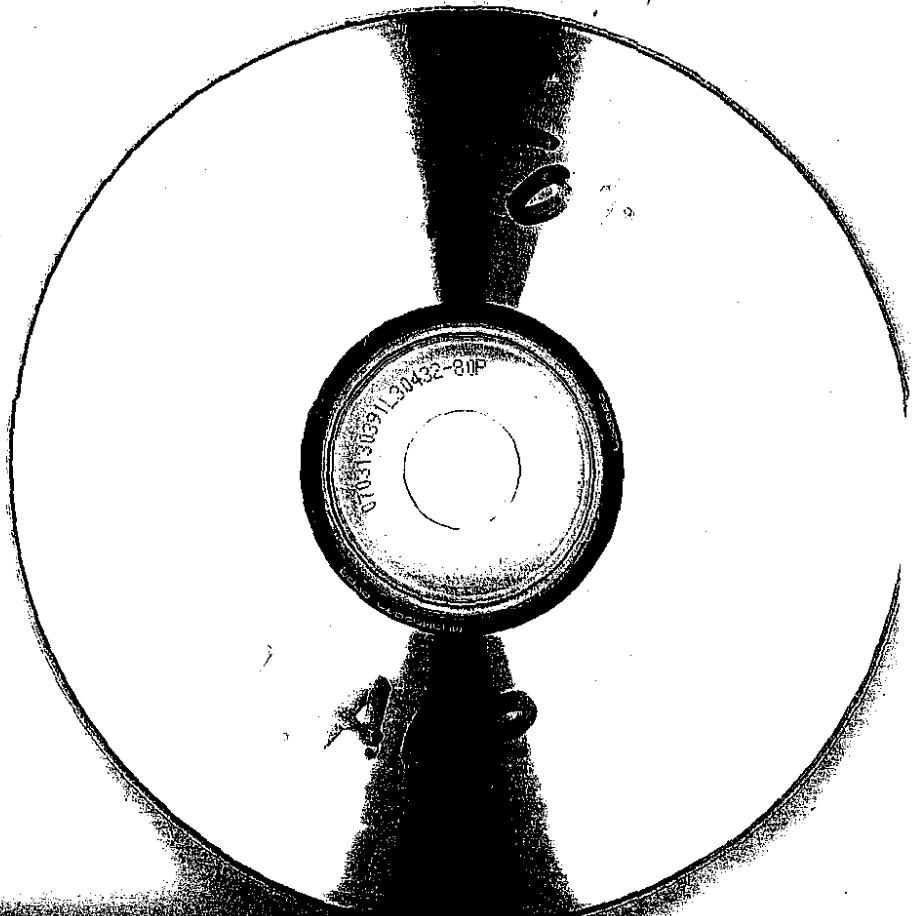

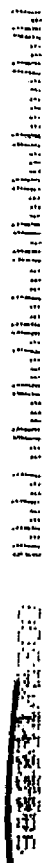
